Organization's Mission Statement:

Reducing food waste and supporting hunger relief one bagel at a time through community activation.

Summary of organization's primary programs and services:

Bagel Rescue is a nonprofit food rescue for bagels, breads and pastries. We rescue unsold items at bagel shops and bakeries and donate them to hunger relief agencies including shelters, food pantries, street outreach efforts, youth programs, and more. We are a responsible solution to put good food to good use to support neighbors in need.

Our main operation is our network of rescue and delivery routes where we are moving approximately 25,000 food items weekly to more than 175 partner agencies. Hundreds of volunteers activate to support this program in 14 counties in GA, and 4 other cities across the US.

We also offer Team Impact Events where groups – usually businesses, schools, civic or faith-based organizations, and families – will gather to learn about the causes we address and then package up thousands of bagels that are distributed into the community. These events are high-energy, fast-paced, and full of impact.

- Community events to build awareness and advocate for our causes
- Monthly partner service project (serving alongside a hunger relief agency to better understand the needs of partners and neighbors)
