**Who is Wholesome Wave Georgia?**

Wholesome Wave Georgia believes that all Georgians in need should have access to fresh, healthy, locally-grown food choices. In Georgia, over 1.4 million people are considered food-insecure and receive federal nutrition assistance including SNAP benefits.

The high cost and low accessibility of fresh foods leave these households with limited options to feed their families. Food insecurity is linked to poverty, obesity, and other diet-related illnesses. The effect of food insecurity on America's families is evident: approximately 65% of adults and 34% of children (ages 2 to 19) are overweight or obese.

We work towards our mission through our core programs: Fresh For Less, Food For Health, and SNAP Connection.

**What Does WWG Stand For?**

**Intern's title:** Fresh for Less Outreach Intern

Wholesome Wave Georgia is seeking a motivated summer intern to serve as a bridge between our Fresh for Less program and the community. This "on-the-ground" role is essential for evaluating program impact and expanding our reach to SNAP participants across Atlanta and Georgia.

- Duration: May 18 to Jul 31, 2026
- Schedule: Weekend and evening availability is required to attend farmers' markets. Weekday hours are flexible and will be dedicated to scheduling visits and administrative support.
- Travel: Must have a reliable personal vehicle; mileage will be reimbursed.

**Key Responsibilities:**

- Field Outreach & Data Collection: Visit at least 10 Fresh for Less partners (primarily farmers markets) to manage WWG info booths, engage with neighbors, and facilitate SNAP customer surveys.
- Logistics & Coordination: Independently schedule and coordinate all market visits and site logistics with partners.
- Technology Management: Set up and manage mobile data collection tools (tablets/surveys) in the field.
- Program Administration: Support the Fresh for Less team with data cleaning, partner communications, and the preparation/shipping of program materials.

The ideal candidate is an outgoing, organized, and professional individual who enjoys being outdoors and talking to people. This role is a perfect fit if you are passionate about food access and want to see how community programs operate in a real-world setting. This role will involve some evening and weekend work, as those are the common times farmers markets operate. You are expected to attend scheduled markets "rain or shine". You must be comfortable lifting 30 pounds to set up Wholesome Wave Georgia's tent and table.
